## She "Needed" an Abortion

Shelly very much "needed" an abortion. Her boyfriend was serving in Iraq in dangerous territory and not giving her

any input about what he wanted her to do. She was being coached by a friend to abort because that friend had a past abortion, but then admitted that her friend got deeper into drugs and alcohol after she aborted her baby. Shelley felt alone and knew that only she was responsible for her decision.

Michelle, our client care manager, was able to share her own story of abortion and gave the vital information Shelly needed to know; her baby's heart was already beating, the first brainwaves could be detected and baby's central nervous system was in place. Shelly stared at Michelle for a brief moment in disbelief. She was completely unaware of the incredible life inside her. Her decision just became more difficult.

As the pressure mounted between Shelly and her boyfriend, they broke up just before her ultrasound exam was scheduled. Her exam revealed the baby was 11 ½ weeks along and baby was showing off arms and legs and bouncing around. She was happy and tearful as she watched her baby move about. Shelly was given pictures of her baby to keep. Although she came to us "needing" an abortion, God revealed the truth to her in a very gentle, loving way by using Michelle, other volunteers and our nurse Miki to help Shelly see beyond abortion.

Shelley's boyfriend returned from Iraq and became more supportive as they began attending our parenting classes together. So far, they have attended 22 classes and have shopped in our Baby Boutique multiple times, earning so many items for their precious baby!

Little Emma was born on October 31st and weighed 8 pounds. Her dad proudly carried her into the clinic to show her off and we all rejoiced at God's goodness!

## He read every brochure in the waiting room...

Samantha is a 16-year-old junior in high school and hasn't told anyone she thinks she might be pregnant and wants to get an abortion. She was on her way to Planned Parenthood when she saw our sign next door. She had taken 2 tests at home and both were positive. Samatha wasn't sure how far along she was. She knows a baby is going to affect her life because she's active in school, plays soccer and her mother had her as a teenager and wasn't ready to have a baby.

As she waited for her pregnancy test results, she was hoping to get information on abortion. During this same time Samatha's boyfriend, Brian, was in the waiting room reading every brochure we had available. Our Client Care Advocate, Kristine, brought Brian back to the consultation room as she told them the test indicated it was positive. Sam and Brian wanted to know about abortion procedures, although she didn't know how far along she was. Kristine was able to educate them by explaining a first and second trimester abortion procedure, using factual information. We were able to show her a 12 week fetal model to give her an idea of the development of her baby. At this point they were thinking abortion was still their best option, but Sam made an appointment to come back in a couple of days for an ultrasound to confirm she had a viable pregnancy.

They arrived looking nervous. During her ultrasound exam the baby move around so much she was shocked. She was 19 weeks along. Brad got tears in his eyes when he saw his baby. Immediately he asked if we could tell if the baby was a girl or a boy. Sam asked for pictures to take with her.

When they left they were still unsure of their decision. A week later they returned to start their first parenting class. The baby's due date is April 12, 2011.

Note: Sam was 19 weeks along, as my grandson's picture is above. If she had gone to an abortion provider there is a very, very high chance she wouldn't have been shown the ultrasound screen and instead been offered a second trimester abortion. As you can see by the picture above, her baby was fully formed at the time of her visit a few weeks ago. Thank you. It's because of you that we're open!

## Legislative Update

Pregnancy clinics across the nation are under attack, but none so much as Washington State. All eyes will be on us as the new legislative session begins January 11, 2011. By the grace of God we survived the 2010 attacks from NARAL Pro Choice America and Planned Parenthood as they tried to pass two bills that would eventually close down all Pregnancy Clinics in Washington State: We're not sure of the exact contents of their upcoming bill, but here's strategy and accusations from NARAL Pro Choice America's website. Keep in mind I can only speak for Options360. They say pregnancy clinics:

NARAL/PP: Harm women and her baby by keeping her from getting pre-natal care as soon as possible.

Options360: We want women in prenatal care as soon as possible. We give them referrals, get them started on maternity health insurance and do several follow up phone calls to make sure they're getting the care they need.

NARAL/PP: Harm women by forcing her to delay an abortion since abortion complications increase with each week of pregnancy.

Options360: When we have a woman who is at serious risk of having an abortion, our first priority is her safety. We get her in for an ultrasound as soon as we can to educate her and give her the tools she needs to make her own decision.

NARAL/PP: Illegally provide pregnancy diagnosis without a medical license.

Options360: Our medical director, Dr. Joe Chang, is a board certified OB/GYN. He reads every ultrasound scan and he assures we are always medically accurate, operating medically by the highest standards.

NARAL/PP: Do not hold client information confidential.

Options360: We are required by law to be HIPPA compliant. We sign a contract with every client stating their medical records will be held in the strictest confidence.

NARAL/PP: Mislead by advertising as though they offered bonified medical services.

Options360: We offer pregnancy testing, pregnancy diagnosis through the use of ultrasound and STD testing and treatment. Each one of these has to be done under the direction and supervision of a physician.

NARAL/PP: Illegally provide medical information by non-medical people.

Options360: If a client asks a medical question to a non-medical person, that person will get a nurse on staff to discuss questions with the client. If a nurse is unavailable at that time, the client is referred onto an urgent care facility or the emergency room.

NARAL/PP: Coerce, manipulate, and emotionally harm women using graphic videos, inappropriate counseling tactics, etc.

Options360: We don't have to use manipulative tactics or graphic videos (in fact we don't even own a graphic video) to convince a woman not to abort. The care we give, the factual literature and the ultrasound screen all speak for themselves, revealing the truth of a beating heart.

We ask for your prayers as we approach this next season. We will be carrying the armor of God.
